

More biochar for Temboan

We build a new biochar processing hut in Temboan. While using the abundant waste wood laying around as well as massive amounts of coconut peels we can at the same time reduce the risk of fires while almost permanently sequestering carbon dioxide from the atmosphere. In the workshop of the sugar factory we have been constructing so-called Kontiki cones for biochar production as well as the biochar drums. These are now in full operation and we are carefully monitoring how much carbon emissions in this way we can prevent from happening.



While surveying the river for a better entrance to our Temboan area from the north we noticed this stem in the river. It turned out to be a most pleasant surprise in the form of the heartwood of an ebony tree! Very valuable and not to be made into biochar as the other stems in and along the Walinsorit river.
